

Parents as Teachers

This family visiting program provides free support to pregnant women and families with infants until their children turn four.

We will visit you at home or anywhere in your community.

You can join if you:

are pregnant or have a child younger than one year old

This program may be good for:

- pregnant women and new parents who want to learn more about how to help their children play, learn, and grow up healthy.



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What happens during a visit?

A trained Parent Educator will visit you regularly and talk with you about how your child is growing. He or she can answer questions and encourage you. Your Parent Educator can also help you receive community services like low-cost child care, healthy foods, and programs for your child.
