



**KIDSNET** is a Rhode Island Health Department tracking system for families and doctors.

**KIDSNET** helps families keep track of their children's vaccinations (shots) and other public health services.

**KIDSNET** reminds families when it is time to visit the doctor for a lead test.

**KIDSNET** provides doctors with an official immunization record for entry to school, daycare, and camp.

**KIDSNET** benefits everyone by helping doctors and families be sure that all kids receive complete preventative healthcare to keep them well.

**KIDSNET** information is private among families, their doctors, and other public health people who provide services to them.

You have the right to limit who has access to your child's information in KIDSNET.
