



2017 SSV Enrollment EZIZ Training Requirements

2017 State Supplied Vaccine, SSV enrollment participation includes completing training modules found in the California EZIZ website <http://eziz.org/eziz-training/>

Training You Need to Complete:

If you are enrolled in the Rhode Island SSV Program, you need to assign a Vaccine Administration Lead to complete Training A. The Vaccine Administration Lead is responsible for sharing training knowledge with all practice staff who administer vaccines. The two Certificates of Completion need be kept on file to be viewed at the request of RIDOH.

A Preparing Vaccines (25 min.)

Select vaccines based on physicians' orders. Identify expired vaccines. Mix, reconstitute, and draw up vaccines.

Administering Vaccines (16 min.)

Identify correct needle lengths, insertion angles, and injection sites for intramuscular (IM) and subcutaneous (SC) injections. Administer IM and SC injections.

If you are newly enrolled in the Rhode Island SSV Program in 2017, or are new to the Vaccine Contact or Back-Up Vaccine Contact role, in addition to completing the above trainings, you will need to complete Training B. Certificates of Completion need be kept on file to be viewed at the request of RIDOH.

B Storing Vaccines (20 min.)

Prepare refrigerators and freezers for vaccine storage. Store vaccines in refrigerators and freezers. Safeguard refrigerator and freezer power supplies.

You need to turn up computer volume to take the training.

There are 7 trainings listed on this website. Only complete the A trainings listed above and if applicable, the B training above.
