

2022 MEDICAL MARIJUANA PROGRAM REPORT TO THE RHODE ISLAND GENERAL ASSEMBLY 7/1/22 – 9/30/22

SEPTEMBER 2022

In accordance with the Edward O. Hawkins and Thomas C. Slater Medical Marijuana Act, § 21-28.6-6(I), the Rhode Island Department of Health (RIDOH) respectfully submits this report on applications for the use of medical marijuana for symptom relief for the time-period of July 1, 2022, to September 30, 2022.

As of September 30, 2022, there were 16,462 active registered patients, 451 active registered caregivers and 518 active authorized purchasers.

The numbers listed above may differ slightly from the Annual Report because the report is looking at active status only. Therefore, if a license status changes from active to inactive during the time the reports are run, the numbers will not match.

1) The number of applications for registrations as a qualifying patient, primary caregiver, or authorized purchaser made to RIDOH: For the time-period of July 1, 2022 to September 30, 2022, RIDOH received 360 new

For the time-period of July 1, 2022 to September 30, 2022, RIDOH received 360 new patient applications, 9 new caregiver applications and 21 new authorized purchaser applications.

2) The number of approved registrations for qualifying patients, primary caregivers, and authorized purchasers:

For the time-period of July 1, 2022 to September 30, 2022 RIDOH approved 415 patient registrations, 11 caregiver registrations and 23 authorized purchaser registrations.

The number of applications approved is larger than the number received due to the fact there were a percentage of applications that were incomplete upon receipt prior to July 1, 2022. When we receive the requisite documentation and/or fees for incomplete applications, the application is approved and the registration is issued at that time.

3) The nature of the debilitating conditions of qualifying patients:

Practitioner Written Certifications contained the following debilitating conditions for the time-period of July 1, 2022 to September 30, 2022:
